Instructions

When the initial interpretive planning process and inventory of interpretive sites was conducted in 2008, it was realized that, given the time frame for the project, it was impossible to visit and review every site within the 500-mile corridor. So only sites, recommended by regional river trail and Greenway staff, were included in the first inventory.

This Site Accession Form is designed to allow any Greenway representative or other stakeholder to recommend sites to be added to the Interpretive Master Plan.

Criteria for Sites to be Considered for Inclusion into the Interpretive Plan:

- Sites are owned or managed by a non-profit organization.
- Sites are owned or managed by a government agency.
- Sites with facilities that have posted hours of operation.
- Sites that visitors can access at any time such as scenic overlooks, self-guiding auto tours or historic district walking tours.
