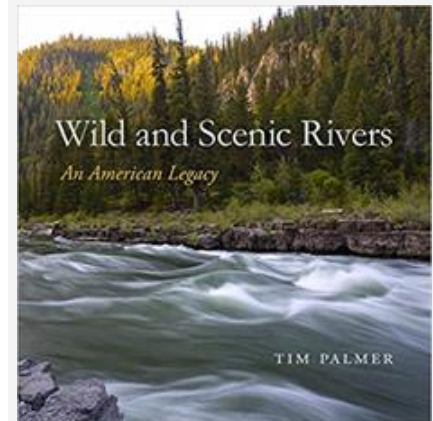

County Trails Initiative Launches

Union County Commissioners voted earlier this month to increase the hotel tax in the county from 3% to 5% in an effort to establish a long-term investment in the future of bike and pedestrian trails in the county. Known as the Union County Trail Initiative, the effort would receive an estimated \$125,000 annually to promote outdoor tourism and trail use, underwrite trail maintenance, and provide capital to invest in future trail expansion. Inaugural Williamsport Cleanup Makes a Big Impact

City Wide Cleanup Bags Half a Ton of Litter

Volunteers from across the greater Williamsport area joined forces this past April for the inaugural Williamsport Cleanup Week; a week-long initiative dedicated to removing litter from valued sites across the city.

Individuals and organizations, with planning assistance from SGP, STEP, and the City officials, removed over 1,245.4 pounds of trash from the streets, parks, and waterways over the course of the 8 day event. On the River Walk alone, SGP and HOW volunteers removed 260 pounds of trash in just under 2 hours. "It was wonderful to see community members united under a common cause of improving the health of their environment and recreational areas," noted SGP Assistant Director Corey Ellison. "We look forward to seeing how this event will continue to grow in the coming years."



The mission of the Susquehanna Greenway Partnership is to envision, create and sustain a greenway along the Susquehanna River to enhance river towns and the lives of current and future generations.
