Baker announces grant awards for Bradford, Tioga counties

HARRISBURG - State Rep. Matt Baker (R-Bradford/Tioga) today announced grant awards for Bradford and Tioga counties from the County Conservation Partnerships Program, administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR).

"I am pleased to see these grants awarded to enhance the quality of life in our communities," Baker said. "It is my hope that projects of this nature continue in Bradford and Tioga counties."

The following projects in Bradford and Tioga counties have been selected to

receive grants:

* The Endless Mountains Heritage Region has been awarded \$195,000 for use in developing river access, water trail signage and other technical assistance.

* The Lumber Heritage Region of PA has been awarded \$125,000 to provide technical support to partner organizations in Tioga and surrounding counties to advance heritage development and the PA Wilds in 2012, in addition to conducting workshops and assisting in the promotion of the maple industry.

* The Pennsylvania Route 6 Heritage Corporation has been awarded \$140,000 to provide technical assistance to communities in Tioga and surrounding counties to implement Heritage Work Plans and coordinate the Artisan Trail for 2012.

* The Susquehanna Greenway Partnership has been awarded \$240,000 for the Susquehanna Greenway Implementation and Technical Assistance program in Bradford and other Pennsylvania counties.

The Community Conservation Partnerships Program includes the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund, the Environmental Stewardship Fund and federal funding sources. It is administered by DCNR's Bureau of Recreation and Conservation to provide financial and technical assistance to local governments, river and trail organizations, land trusts and other nonprofits for park, recreation, conservation and greenway projects.
