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Erosion study done along Millersburg riverbank

MILLERSBURG • Millersburg Borough has completed an erosion control study, funded in part by a grant awarded through the Susquehanna Greenway Partnership.

The study considered alternatives for controlling erosion at Riverfront Park. When the Susquehanna River rises during spring floods and high water events, the riverbank erodes. Millersburg Borough is searching for

solutions and funding to slow or stop the erosion.

The study, conducted by Brinjac Engineering, Harrisburg, examined the erosion problems and suggested several alternatives. The Borough is reviewing the possible solutions and seeking county, state and federal grant funding for actual construction. The study serves as a key component of the grant requests.

The study was funded in

part by a grant from the Community Conservation Partnerships Program, Environmental Stewardship Fund, under the administration of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Bureau of Reclamation and Conservation. The grant was awarded through the Susquehanna Mini-Grant Program of the Susquehanna Greenways Partnership.
