National Civilian Community Corps to help with flood cleanup

BERWICK — A team from the National Civilian Community Corps will visit here and Bloomsburg this spring to help with flood cleanup along the Susquehanna River, a press release says. Local volunteers are invited to help out.

During their time here, the 11 men and women, ages 18 to 24, will be working in downtown Shickshinny to pick up litter and clean streets. The team will partner with the

Susquehanna Warrior Trail Council for two days to remove flood mud and restore the riverside trail.

The volunteers will spend four days in Berwick conducting riverbank, litter, and brush cleanup in Test Track Park. Then they will help with recovery work in Bloomsburg's Town Park, which has been closed to the public since the flood.

- Saturday, March 17, along the Warrior Trail, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.;
- Saturday, March 24, Bloomsburg Town Park, 9-11 a.m.
