## What is the Susquehanna Greenway?

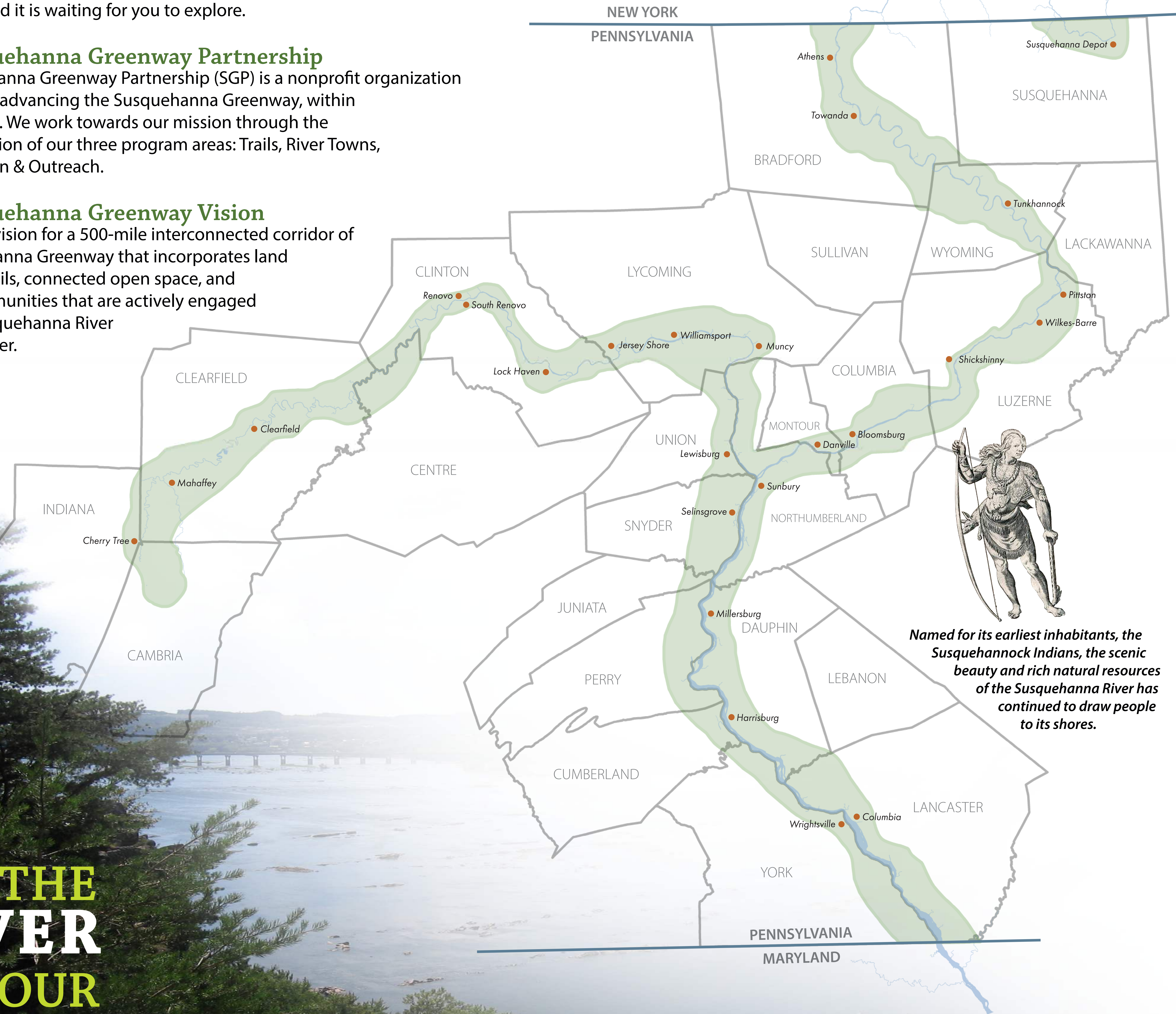

The Susquehanna Greenway Partnership (SGP) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to advancing the Susquehanna Greenway, within Pennsylvania. We work towards our mission through the implementation of our three program areas: Trails, River Towns, and Education & Outreach.

## The Susquehanna Greenway Vision

SGP holds a vision for a 500-mile interconnected corridor of the Susquehanna Greenway that incorporates land and water trails, connected open space, and vibrant communities that are actively engaged with the Susquehanna River and each other.
