DESCRIPTION

Begin at the PFBC Watsontown Access, just off of Dickson Avenue. As you paddle downriver towards

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Lewisburg, trees and farm fields dominate this landscape, as
well as unique bridges and wildlife, including eagles, waterfowl, and OR MASS responsible.

This trip includes an optional island lunch break at Milton State Park around mile 4.5 in your trip (look for a channel on river left). You must paddle on the left side of the island to reach the boat launch located beneath the river bridge. The northern half of the park has day use facilities and the southern half remains in a wooded state for hiking and nature study with a network of walking trails around the whole island. If you choose not to stop you may navigate around the island on river right.

Take-out: Lewisburg Landing at St George Street (river right)

At the put-in, there is a parking lot at the end of Park Road, just off of Dickson Avenue. At the take-out at Lewisburg Landing, where St George Street meets the river, there is a small gravel area to pull-off, however, nearby street parking is recommended.
