GRANTS & OPPORTUNITIES

DCNR AWARDS \$79.4 MILLION IN GRANTS

The Susquehanna Greenway Partnership (SGP) is pleased to announce that it has been awarded a grant in the generous amount of \$299,700 from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR). This funding will play a crucial role in advancing the outdoor recreation opportunities within the Susquehanna Greenway in Pennsylvania.

Canoe Access Development Fund | November 18 Deadline

The Western Pennsylvania Conservancy's Canoe Access Development Fund helps to make the region's rivers and streams more accessible for outdoor recreation such as canoeing, kayaking and fishing. The fund goes toward watershed groups, conservation organizations, paddle clubs, agencies and other eligible parties to develop canoe and kayak access sites across Western Pennsylvania. **LEARN MORE**.

PFBC Boating Facility Grant Program | November 30 Deadline

Administered by the Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission, the Boating Facility Grant program provides grants for planning, acquisition, development, expansion, and rehabilitation of public boating facilities located on the waters of the Commonwealth. The goal of the program is to ensure Pennsylvania's recreational boaters have the highest quality boating facilities. **LEARN MORE**.

Boating Access | Sub-program of the Sport Fish Restoration Grant

The Boating Access sub-program of the Sport Fish Restoration Grant program provides federal funds for facilities that create or add to public access for recreational boating and improvements to waterways that increase access to recreational boating opportunities. **LEARN MORE**.

The watershed mini grants can be used to support projects in three areas: water quality monitoring, watershed restoration, and organizational promotion and outreach. Grants of up to \$3,500 may be awarded for water quality monitoring and restoration projects. Grants of up to \$2,500 may be awarded for promotion and community outreach projects. **LEARN MORE**.

T-Mobile Hometown Grants | December 31 Deadline

T-Mobile Hometown Grants is a \$25 million, five-year initiative to support the people and organizations who help small towns across America thrive and grow. Hometown Grants are given every quarter to up to 25 small towns. Apply for funding to support a community project of your choice, like revitalizing or repurposing a historic structure, creating a downtown asset or destination, or improving a space where friends and neighbors gather. Projects that add to a sense of place or could lead to further investment are of particular interest. LEARN MORE.

NPS Challenge Cost Share Award Program | January 10 Deadline

Matching awards of up to \$25,000 are available for a range of project ideas that promote climate change adaptations and improved access and opportunities for outdoor recreation, environmental stewardship, and education in our National Parks, National Trails, and/or Wild and Scenic Rivers. This is a great opportunity to partner with your local national park site! **LEARN MORE**.
