



We are thrilled to welcome **two incredible new AmeriCorps members** to the SGP team!


**Kyle Ehmann** will be lending his talents to our River Towns program. **Kat Hendricks** will be bringing her skills to our Communications program.

## **LOW WATER: KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!**

The Susquehanna River is currently experiencing low water levels. Before paddling, always check river gages and consult with local outfitters for the latest conditions. Paddlers are encouraged to target trips upriver from dammed areas where water levels may be more reliable.





# LEARN MORE

<u>Lumber Heritage Region Mini-Grant</u> | September 30 Deadline

This annual funding opportunity supports projects that celebrate, preserve, and promote the rich lumbering heritage of northwestern and north central Pennsylvania. The program is open to nonprofits, municipalities, educational institutions, and community organizations located within the 15-county Lumber Heritage Region: Cambria, Cameron, Centre, Clarion, Clearfield, Clinton, Elk, Forest, Indiana, Jefferson, Lycoming, McKean, Potter, Tioga, and Warren. **LEARN MORE**.

### DCNR's All-Terrain Vehicle & Snowmobile Grant | September 30 Deadline

All-Terrain Vehicle and Snowmobile projects include the planning, acquisition of land, development, rehabilitation, maintenance, purchase of equipment for maintenance and construction, and development of educational programs related to ATV and/or snowmobile trails and facilities. ONLY ATV or snowmobile projects should be submitted. **LEARN MORE**.

### Cycling Activation in PA Mini Grants | October 3 Deadline

Administered by the Pennsylvania Environmental Councile (PEC), the Cycling Activation in PA Mini Grant Program is designed to support projects and programs that promote opportunities for cycling centered on gravel roads, mountain bike trails, and multi-use pathways across Pennsylvania. **LEARN MORE**.

### 2025 Water Trail Mini Grants Program | October 31 Deadline

Administered by the Pennsylvania Environmental Councile (PEC), grants are available on a competitive basis for projects that implement the PA Water Trail Program's eight guiding principles: Partnership, Stewardship, Volunteerism, Education, Conservation Community Vitality, Diversity, Wellness and Well-being. **LEARN MORE**.

### **DEP Environmental Education Grants** | November 14 Deadline

Administered by the Department of Environmental Protection, the Environmental Education Grants Program funds projects like hands-on student programs, teacher workshops, and community conservation efforts. Educators, schools, nonprofits, businesses, and more can apply to help people of all ages learn to care for our natural environment. **LEARN MORE**.

### Statewide Waterway Access Grant | Rolling Basis

Funds community-driven projects that address climate challenges & reduce pollution while strengthening communities through thoughtful implementation. **LEARN MORE**.

### Community Heart & Soul Seed Grant Program | Rolling Basis

Administered by The Pennsylvania Humanities Council (PHC) and Community Heart & Soul, this program seeks to help PA small cities, townships, and boroughs to implement the Community Heart & Soul model by providing \$10,000 matching grants to resident-led groups in communities with populations of 2,500 to 30,000. **LEARN MORE**.

### Peer & Circuit Rider Grants | Open Year-Round

These DCNR grant programs fund projects that help municipalities, counties, multi-municipal partnerships, and council of governments to increase local capacity for recreation, parks, and conservation. **LEARN MORE**.
